Volunteers descend on Cowtown for annual G.I.V.E Day

Media are invited to visit Old Cowtown Museum between 8:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturday when more than 140 volunteers from Royal Caribbean Cruises Ltd. and Communities-in-Schools will spruce up Cowtown's buildings and grounds.
