Wine Mosey

Wine tasting event fundraiser for Old Cowtown Museum

Only at Old Cowtown Museum could wine tasting and stagecoach rides make such a perfect combination. The museum is hosting its 2nd Annual Wine Mosey from 5-8 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 12. Tickets are \$35 per person, and they are available in person at Cowtown, by phone at (316) 350-3311 or online at WichitaTIX.com. The event is sponsored by Historic Wichita Cowtown, Inc., and it is a fundraiser for the museum. Cowtown is located at 1865 W. Museum Blvd.

With the purchase of a ticket, attendees may visit four wine stations located in the Fritz Snitzler's Saloon, Drugstore, First Arkansas Valley Bank and General Store buildings. There will be a varied assortment of red and white wines available from area distributors: Worldwide Wine and Spirits, Lenexa; Glazers, Wichita; Standard Beverage Corporation, Wichita; and LDF Sales and Distributing, Wichita.

Dinner will be outdoors where visitors will be surrounded by the sounds of live entertainment. The menu consists of pulled pork brisket donated by Cargill, Brookville cole slaw (from the renowned Brookville Hotel restaurant in Abilene, Kan.) and cowboy beans. There will also be gunfight re-enactments, stagecoach rides, a show by the Dixie Lee Saloon Girls, a blacksmith demonstration and outdoor antique bowling – complete with a wooden bowling ball.

Rounding out the entertainment will be a live auction with the chance to bid on dinners, a weekend excursion at a working Kansas ranch and the opportunity for up to six people to use local law enforcement's shooting range simulator.

All money raised by the Wine Mosey will be used to fund future additions to Cowtown and to enhance its education program that serves both youth and adults.
